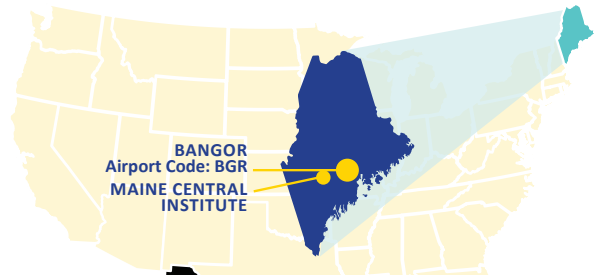


# Maine Central Institute
